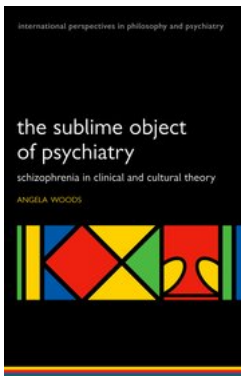

**Abstract**

There is growing recognition that psychiatric consumer, survivor or ex-patient perspectives are not well integrated into disability studies work and academic discourse more generally. While important has focused on whether the preferred model step is an independent mad studies discourse or a disability studies framework more inclusive of all voices, the broader consequences of the absence have been largely overlooked. The purpose of this review is to highlight these major consequences of the absence of ex-patient or CSX perspectives. The CSX includes greater representation and (2) clinical professionalization of psychiatric disability compared with other forms of disability, and (3) barriers and obstacles to training and advancement of academics for doctoral students and faculty with psychiatric disabilities.

**Abstract** With its increasingly integrative view in psychiatry, phenomenology has become one of the most important research topics in contemporary phenomenological psychiatry. A focus of concern since not only allows for an integration of different phenomenological concepts, but also for a phenomenologically oriented understanding of shared social space. In this article, we investigate the role of shared social space in the phenomenology of schizophrenia. In our article we first develop a general concept of social space in order to describe the phenomenally social nature of human experience, arguing that it is constituted by a range of sensory, intersubjective and cognitive capacities that experience and structure. In a second concept of social space, we describe the different dimensions of social space, such as the individual, personal, communal, public and the virtual space. We continue the discussion with a critical review on schizophrenia and finally discuss the therapeutic consequences of our analysis. Implications for social-psychiatric practice, further research, treatment and open dialogue can be regarded as attempts to limit the isolating and alienating effects of social space for both people with schizophrenia and the communities they live in.

**Abstract** In this article, we discuss the role of phenomenology in the development of clinical knowledge, health policies and social identities. We focus on the work of Lars Rosenbock (2013) "Early psychosis as a mirror of biologist controversies in post war German, Anglo-Saxon and Soviet psychiatry". We argue that phenomenology provides a critical perspective on the biological and medical models of psychosis, and offers an alternative way of understanding the social and cultural dimensions of mental illness. We discuss the implications of this perspective for clinical practice, health policy, and social identity. We conclude that phenomenology is a valuable tool for understanding the complexity of psychosis and for developing a more holistic and humanistic approach to mental health care.
